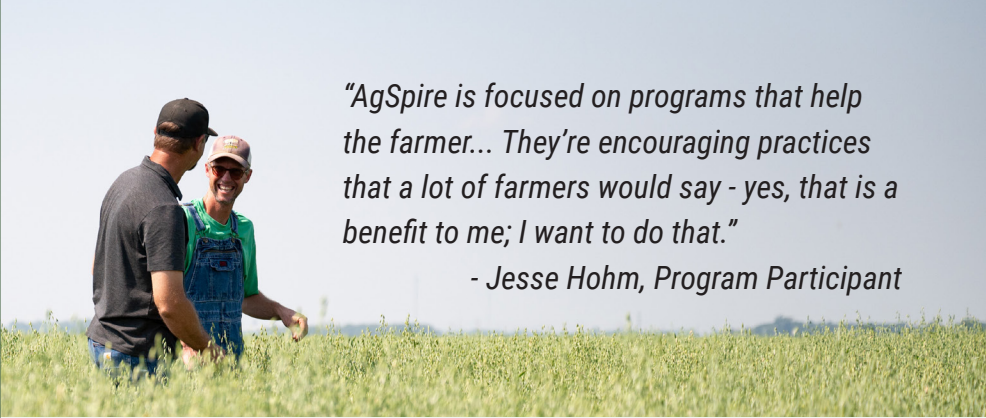

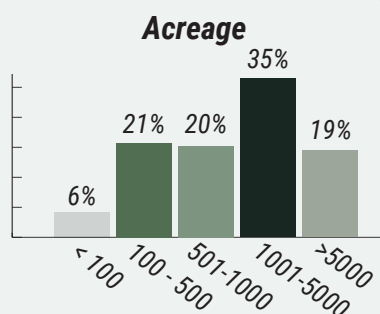
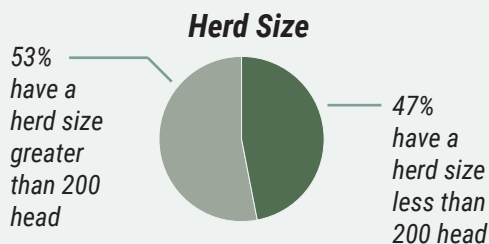

Quarterly Insights Q3 2024

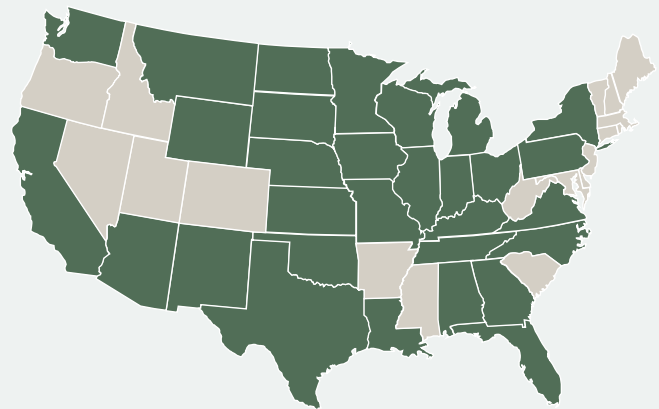
Launched in January 2024, AgSpire's producer network enables effective recruitment for supply shed programs and interventions. In this quarterly report, we highlight the on-the-ground impact and implementation successes observed in the programs offered through the network.

This approach makes progress toward sustainability goals for our partners and clients, while achieving results on the ground for farmers and ranchers.

89% have a diversified operation, with both crops and livestock.

acres seeded into conservation cover under the programs in our Network.

In addition to **conservation cover**, our Technical Assistance Team helped producers implement or expand their use of **no-till and conservation tillage; conservation crop rotations; nutrient management; and herd management**.

With these practices completed, we issued our first producer payments in Q3 - with an estimated **140** producers to receive program payments by the end of 2024.
