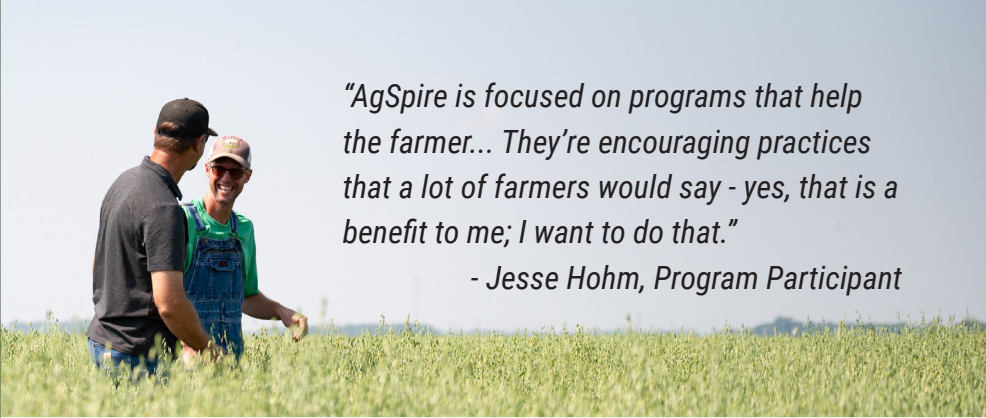

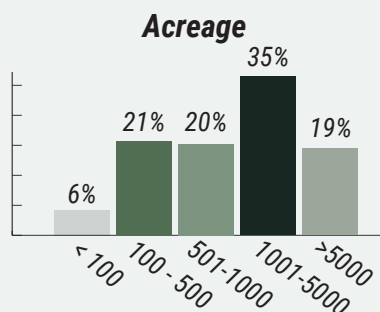
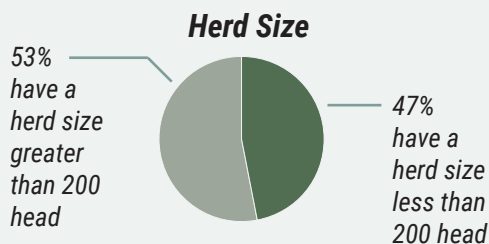
## Quarterly Insights Q3 2024

Through the network, we offer voluntary incentive programs centered around conservation and regenerative practices, with one-on-one technical assistance to help producers reach their land and business goals.

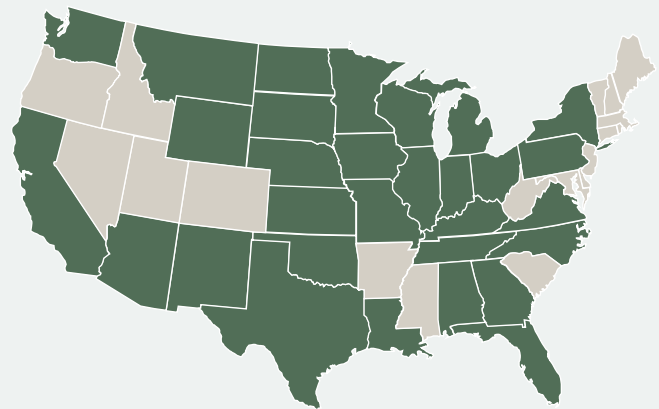

In addition to **conservation cover**, our Technical Assistance Team helped producers implement or expand their use of **no-till and conservation tillage; conservation crop rotations; nutrient management; and herd management**.

With these practices completed, we issued our first producer payments in Q3 - with an estimated **140** producers to receive program payments by the end of 2024.
