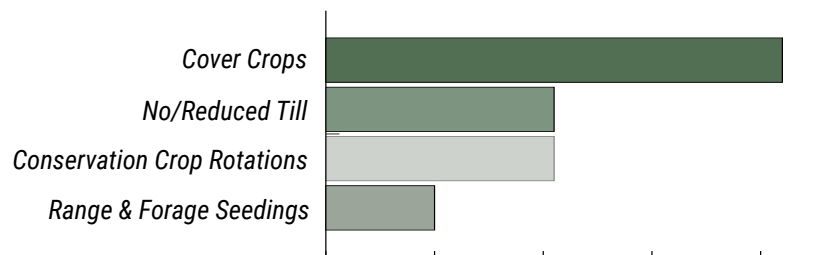

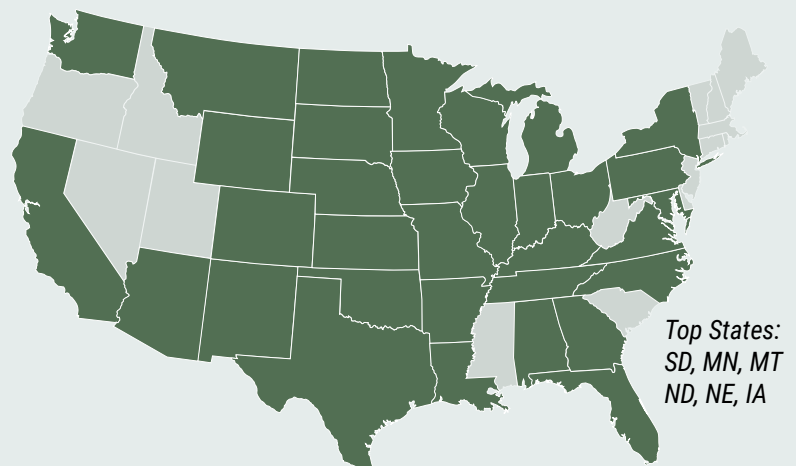
Over 20 different crops represented, with corn, soybeans, and alfalfa being the most common
